

Tyler Woods Benefit



On June 6, 2009, the Port Crane Fire Department will hold a benefit for Tyler Woods at the fire station, 844 Route 369, in Port Crane (across from the entrance to Chenango Valley State Park). Tyler is the stepson of former Port Crane firefighter Rebecca Fletcher and grandson of Port Crane Firefighter Tom Fletcher.

In October of 2008, Tyler was diagnosed with Stage Four Adrenocortical Carcinoma. When discovered the tumor was the size of a baseball but soon grew to the size of a softball and spread to the lungs. Tyler has been traveling back and forth to Albany Medical ever since, enduring constant cycles of chemotherapy in order to fight the cancer. Tyler has a hard journey ahead of him and we want to support him and his family at this difficult time.

On Saturday, June 6, from 1 pm to 5 pm, the Port Crane Fire Department will host a benefit for Tyler. There will be a spaghetti dinner, bake sale, raffles, a Chinese auction and live auction.
