FF Shaller passed away at his home on Thursday Morning 4/5/2012. FF Shaller spent 49 years serving his community as an active and life member of the P.D.F.D. He was the P.D.F.D.'s delegate to the Broome County Firefighters association for many years. FF Shaller also was an active member of the Broome County Firefighters association and was the Chairman of their Recruitment Committee.
